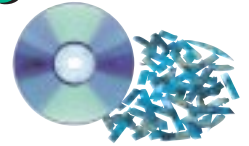

This new data shredder is designed for desk use. As it is an all-rounder, it shreds paper, credit cards, access entry cards, I.D.s and CD-ROMs. The new concept allows you to shred CD-ROMs in 4 mm strip cut as well as in cross cut particles.
